RESOLUTION

The Board of Education of the North Clay Community Unit District No. 25 at its regular meeting on July 11, 2005 adopted this non-binding resolution opposing the construction of a hog raising facility on Bobwhite Road as hereinafter set forth:

WHEREAS, there is a current plan to construct and operate a hog raising facility, commonly known as Bible Pork No. 4 on Bobwhite Road approximately 1.8 miles southwest of the schools operated by the North Clay Community Unit District No. 25; and

WHEREAS, the School District regularly utilizes the Bobwhite Road for the transportation of students between their residences and the school operated by the School district; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Education is concerned that the additional truck traffic resulting from the operation of the Bible Pork #4 hog raising facility will create safety problems related to the transportation of District students on the Bobwhite Road and

WHEREAS, the Board of Education is concerned that the odors generated by the operation of a hog raising facility in close proximity to the district's schools will result in an unhealthy and unpleasant environment for District students, thereby negatively impacting the School District's educational program,

NOW THEREFORE, the Board of Education of the North Clay Community Unit School District No. 25 adopts this non-binding resolution expressing its opposition to the planned construction of the Bible Pork No. 4 hog raising facility on Bobwhite Road and encourages the county Board of Clay County, Illinois to reject this proposed construction plan.
